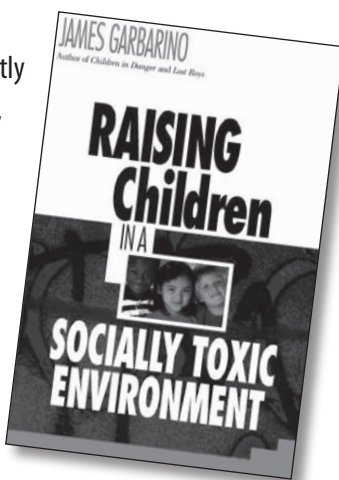
KEYNOTE SPEAKER



Dr. James Garbarino

Nationally recognized child maltreatment expert Dr. James Garbarino will address the impact of family and community violence and abuse on child development and offer key interventions to deal with these effects. Dr. Garbarino currently holds the Maude C. Clark Chair in Humanistic Psychology at Loyola University of Chicago and is Director of the Center for Human Rights of Children at Loyola. Prior to his current position he was the Elizabeth Lee Vincent Professor of Human Development at Cornell University and from 1985-1994 was President of the Erickson Institute for Advanced Study in Child Development.

Dr. Garbarino is frequently consulted for television, magazine and newspaper reports on children and families. His numerous awards recognize his efforts on behalf of abused and neglected children. He has authored nearly two dozen books including, *"Lost Boys: Understanding Why Our Sons Turn Violent and How We Can Save Them;"* *"See Jane Hit: Why Girls Are Growing More Violent and What We Can Do About It;"* *"Raising Children in a Socially Toxic Environment;"* and, *"Parents Under Siege: Why You Are the Solution, Not the Problem in Your Child's Life."*
